#### **COMMUNITY MEAL SERVICE**

We have now hosted 4 free community meals in our church. On a rainy Tuesday in June 26 volunteers served 186 meals. 69 guests ate with us and 94 took meals home with them. We blame the weather on the turnout. The cooks have fine-tuned their efforts - and now plan to start cooking just 3 hours before serving. Even more

volunteers have joined our efforts.

We have been approved to receive some free food for this meal from the USDA Commodities program - which will cut down on our cost per meal quite a bit. They had to approve our storage space and temperatures in them; check that we had a pest control contract; and approve our inventory control. We will be receiving our ground beef, green beans and elbow macaroni from them monthly.

#### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES**

The Mission Committee is asking for donations of school supplies this month. This year we are helping needy high school students. Their needs are different than those of younger students that we have helped in the past. It was brought to our attention that some high school students are, in fact, very needy. 50% of the students at LHS are eligible for free lunches. There will be

a bin in the narthex for the following supplies. Don't forget to continue donating personal hygiene items as well. Communities In Schools monitor these needs and donations.
